# Things to know:

For morning break, your child will be provided with a piece of fruit provided by the Government's Fruit scheme. However, your child can bring in their own healthy snack if preferred (no crisps or chocolate please).

# Things to know:



Please send your child in with their reading book and diary every day. Reading books will be changed once a week

Children's **reading** diaries should be signed 3 times a week. Library books will be changed on Wednesdays.

A new set of spellings will be sent out on a to practise at home ready for a test the following week. Year 1 will also have a reading sheet with the two sounds they have learnt that week.
