

# The Great Snowperson Competition

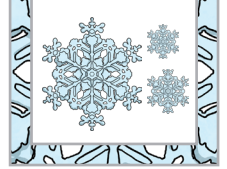
5 Yesterday, Brownley's Annual Snowperson Competition

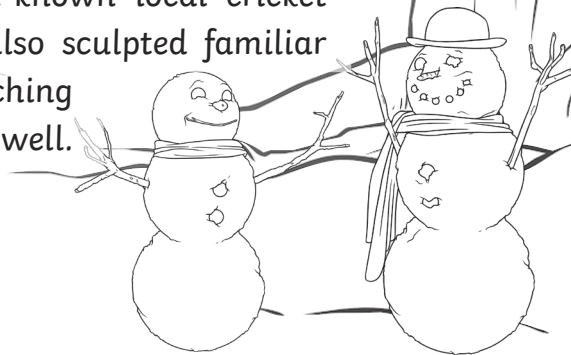

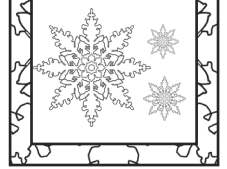
