- I can retell a story.

Literacy

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- I can manage my feelings and emotions e.g. stop, give yourself a cuddle, take a deep breath and talk about the problem and my feelings.
- I can continue to consider the needs and feelings of others.
- I can identify and name healthy foods.
- I can understand the importance of healthy food choices.
- I can listen to the ideas of others.
- I can find solutions to disagreements, with support from adults using the restorative approach.

Maths

- I have a deep understanding of numbers 1 – 10
- I can combine two numbers – part/whole
- I can identify missing parts for numbers within 5
- I can count, order, recognise and use numbers (matching numeral and quantity) to 10 and beyond.
- I can begin to count beyond 20.
- I can add and subtract using number sentences.
- I can understand and explore the difference between odd and even numbers according to their 'shape' linked to sharing.
- I can spot errors in a pattern.
- I can name my patterns.
- I can compare and then measure height and length using cubes.
- I can use the correct vocabulary to compare and order objects by height & length.

Understanding of the world

- I know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on experiences and what has been read in class.
- I know about the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling (growing food and farming).
- I know that Christians celebrate Easter.
- I can identify symbols and signs of Easter.
- I can identify and recognise the features of Spring.
- I know what plants need to grow.
- I can explain the life cycles of animals such as frogs, minibeasts, chicks.
- To use the IWB to play games and use programmes.

Physical Development

- I can move in time to a piece of music, following the rhythm and use counting to help keep in time.
- I can copy and create actions in time to a piece of music.
- I can communicate ideas through movement, demonstrating confidence and imagination.
- I can hold scissors safely and correctly and cut out large shapes.
- I can write letters using the correct letter formation and control the size of the letters formed.
