A typical day

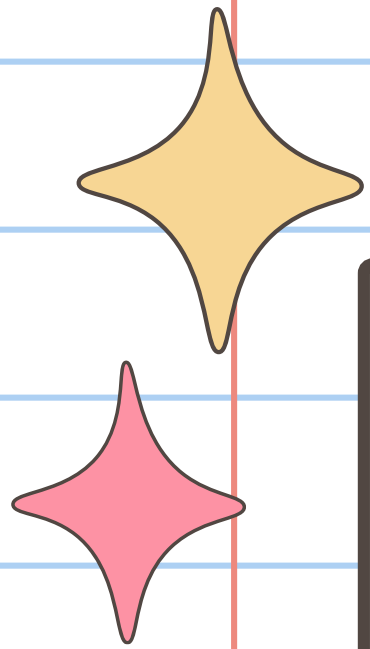


8:40 Gates open on the KS2 playground

It gets extremely busy at the gate area so please make sure your child knows whereabouts to meet you.



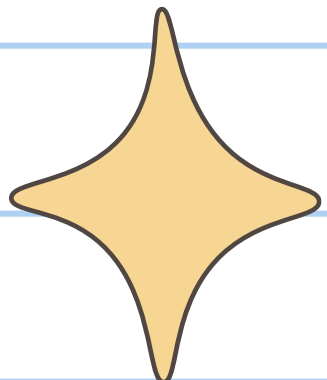
The Curriculum

- Our English curriculum is text based, this is where we use a good quality text for our reading focus and use it to inspire our writing

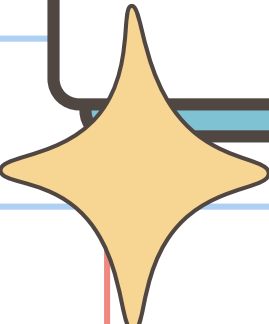
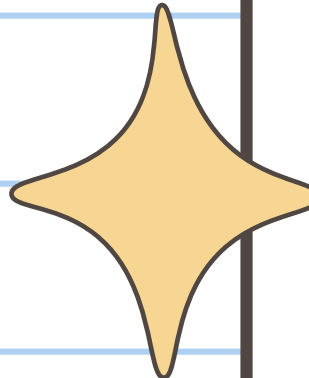




What We Will Learn

Summer Term

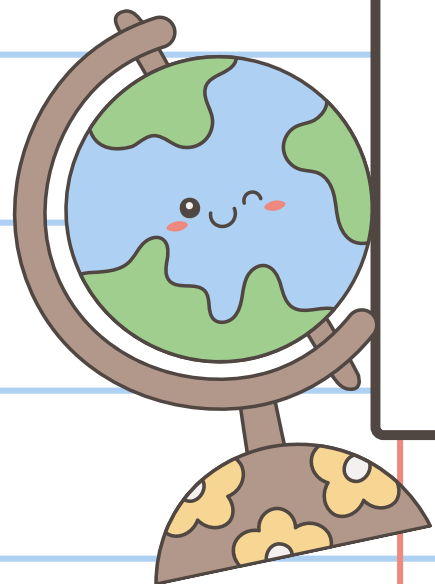
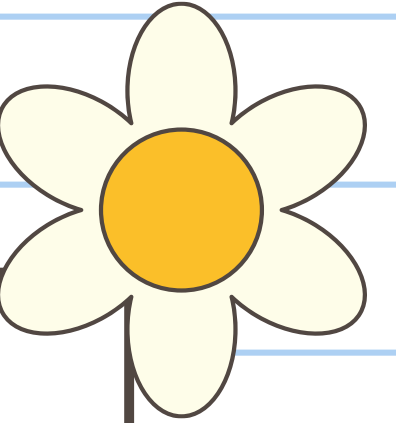
During this term, our topic will be a geography based topic called "Where do we live?" This will focus on where we live and where this is in relation to the World.

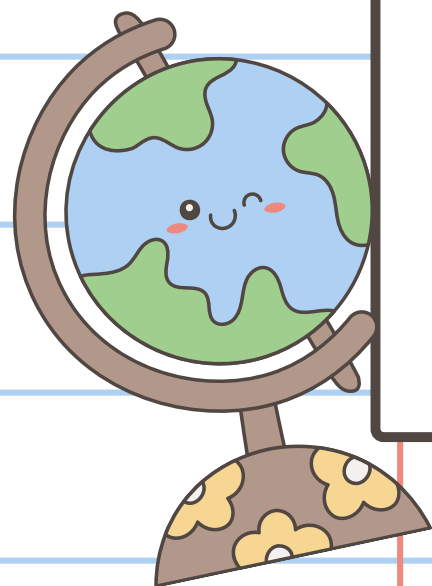
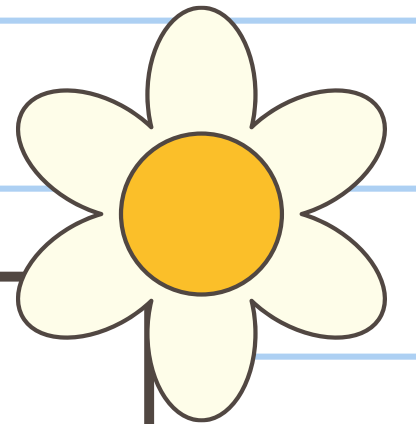
The children are expected to read to a parent or carer 3 times a week and have their reading diaries signed.

Year 4 Multiplication Check

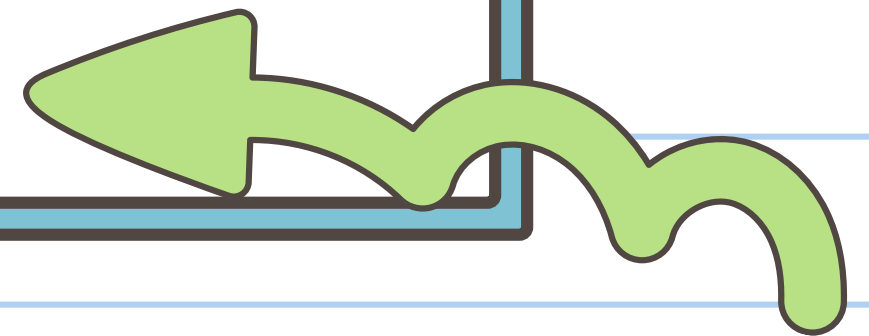
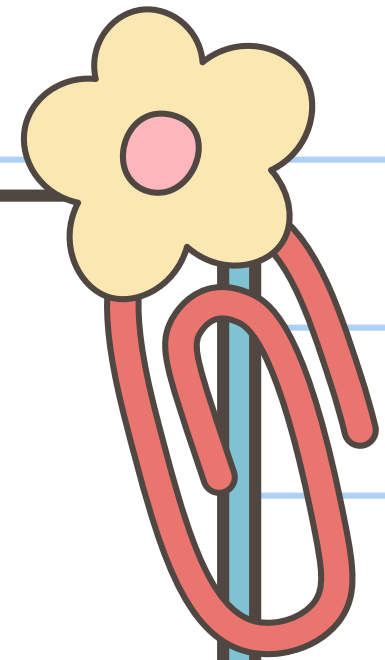
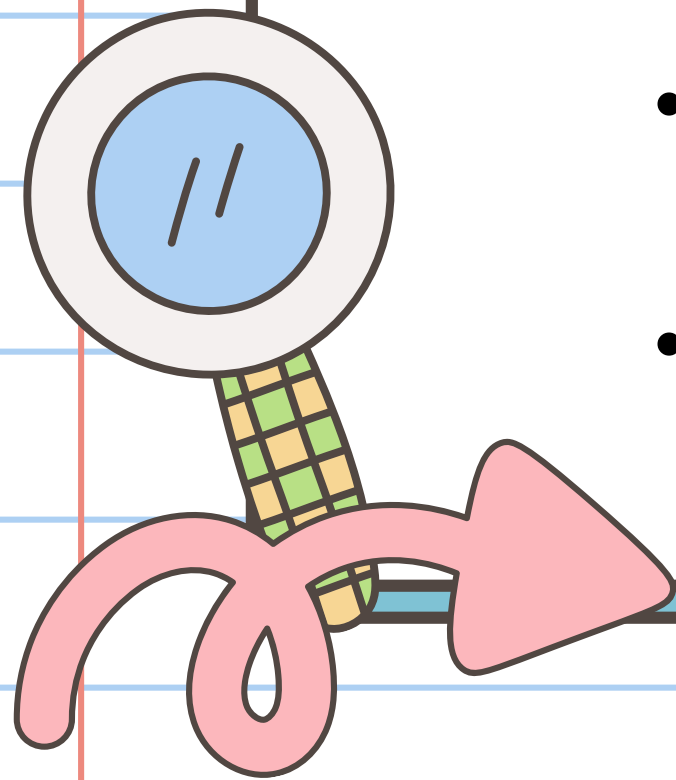
June 2027

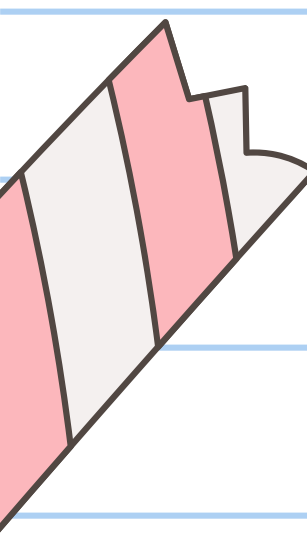
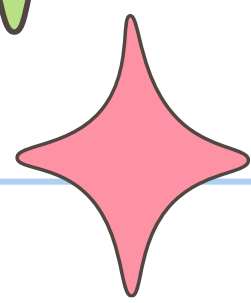
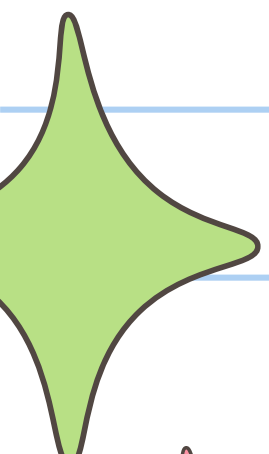


Whitemoor Lakes

During the Summer term, we will go on a 2 night residential to Whitemoor Lakes, the dates of this are: 28–30th April 2027

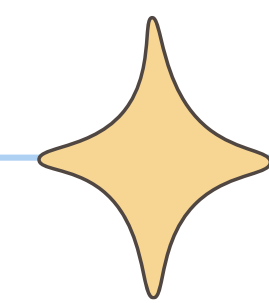
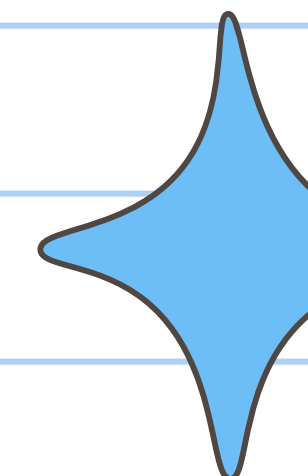
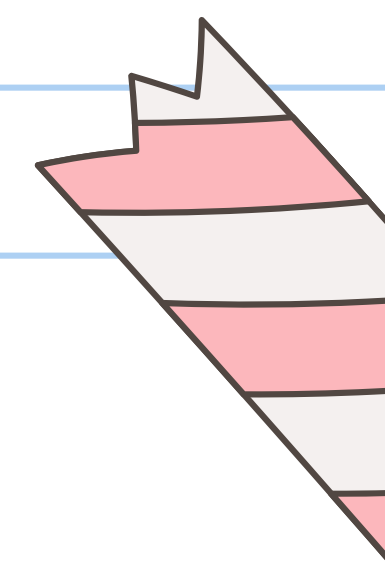

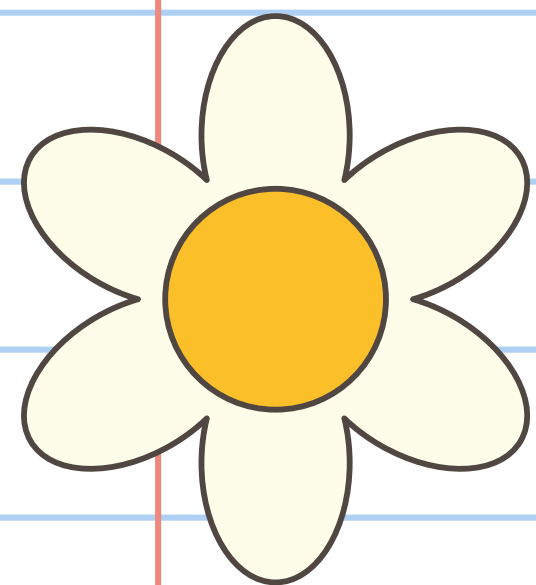


Internet Safety

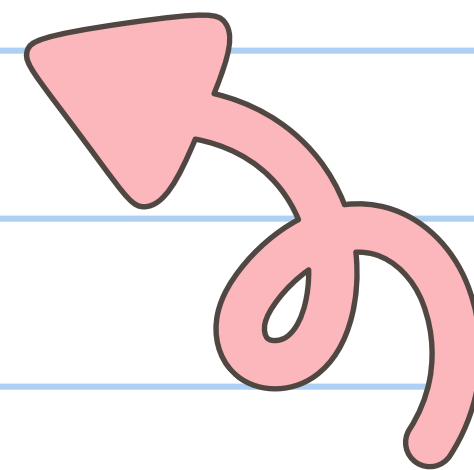
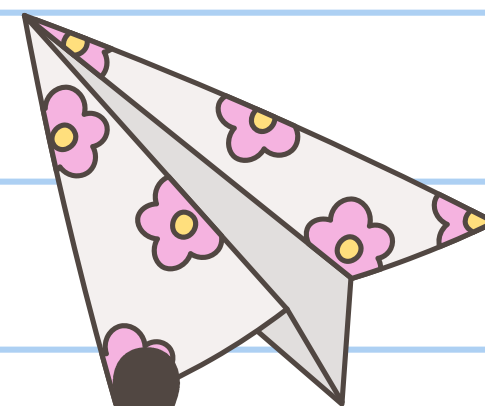
In the first half term, we will learning about e-safety in class.
