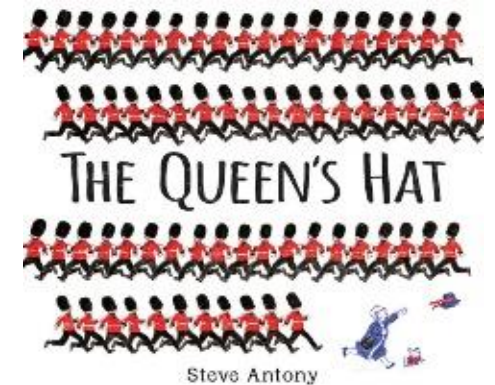
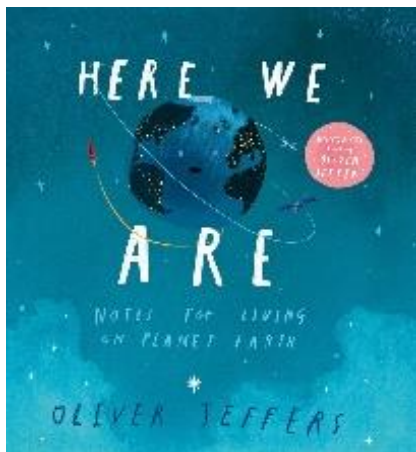


Where in the world?

<p>Week 1</p>	<p>Who is part of the United Kingdom?</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 1 Hedgehogs will be looking at comparing numbers of objects within 50 and ordering them. Year 1 Squirrels are looking at Numbers to 50 and will be looking at recognising numbers to 50, counting objects to 50, and counting forwards and backwards to 50. Year 2 Shrews will start their new unit about fractions. They will recognise a half and quarter then find a half. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be using our times table knowledge of our x2, x5 and x10 tables to help us solve problems.</p> <p>In English this week we will look at our new book, 'The Queen's Hat'. Y1 Squirrels and Hedgehogs will be mapping the story, and looking at powerful verbs featured in the text. Y2 Shrews will learn how to use apostrophes to mark where letters are missing in spelling. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be reading our new story 'The Queens Hat' and looking at all of the exciting vocabulary in the book. They will also generate powerful verbs. Both classes will also be celebrating World Book Day!</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will move around the classrooms to learn about each country which is part of the UK. They will colour in a map of the UK and label the main cities.</p> <p>Challenge - Can they point out the North, South, East and West associated with maps and compass?</p> <p>In PE this half term we are focussing on Yoga. This week our focus is <i>Balance</i>, looking to develop our balance and coordination by stretching up and forward bending.</p> <p>In PSHE this week we learning how we can keep body healthy.</p> <p>In RE we will focus on worship and ceremonies. This week we will look at and talk about pictures of people involved in different aspects of religious worship e.g. singing, praying, playing musical instruments, dancing. Draw out some of the similarities and differences in the way they worship.</p> <p>In Music this week we will listen to and appraise our song for the unit 'Zootime'. We will then complete a variety of warm-up games, learn to sing the song.</p> <p>Year 1/2 I.C.T is animated story books. We will be drawing and creating our pictures for our book and start to add text to a page. Children will also know the difference between a traditional book and an e-book.</p>
<p>Week 2</p>	<p>Where do I live?</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 1 Hedgehogs will be focusing on counting in 2s and 5s as well as solving addition and subtraction word problems. Y1 Squirrels will be looking at different ways to represent numbers to 50 this week. We'll compare different numbers of objects using the < and > signs, and order numbers to 50.</p> <p>Year 2 Shrews will continue their unit on fractions. This week they will find a quarter and three quarters. They will all also find other fractions such as one third. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be looking at division structures and explain how some objects can be grouped and how to calculate them.</p>

	<p>In English this week we will continue to look at our class book, 'The Queen's Hat'. Y1 and Y2 will write their own version of the story changing the object.</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will find where they live on a map of the UK. They will name and locate nearby towns and cities.</p> <p>Challenge - Can they name a few towns in the south and north of the UK?</p> <p>In PE this week as part of our topic on Yoga we are working on <i>All Fours</i>, to develop balance and agility through working on all fours.</p> <p>In PSHE this week we learning what relaxed means and identify things that make us feel relaxed/stressed.</p> <p>In RE this week we will focus on the Christian faith and identify actions, gestures and rituals used as part of their worship and ceremonies and think about why they might be important to believers.</p> <p>In Music this week we will listen to and appraise 'Kingston Town'. We will then complete a variety of warm-up games, continue to learn the song introduced last week and learn to play the tune on the glockenspiel.</p> <p>Year 1/2 I.C.T is animated story books. Children will open their previously saved work, add animations to their story and overwrite any changes that they might make.</p>
Week 3	<p>Can we make a famous landmark?</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 1 Hedgehogs will be starting a new unit which looks at introducing length and height. In particular we will be focusing on comparing length and height as well as looking at non-standard units of measure. Year 1 Squirrels are looking at counting forwards and backwards in 2s this week. We'll then move on to counting in 5's before solving word problems involving addition and subtraction. Year 2 Shrews will continue their unit on fractions. They will understand the whole and the part. Then they will learn to count in halves and quarters. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be calculating equal groups in division.</p> <p>In English this week we will look at our new book, 'Here We Are'. Y1 will be looking at using adjectives to describe our planet. Y2 Shrews will be generating expanded noun phrases to describe our planet. They will then use conjunctions to join clauses. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be creating our own adjectives and then using them in sentences with the correct sentence structure.</p> <p>In Creative Learning children will be making their own structures based on famous landmarks found in the UK. They will learn how to join materials to ensure it is strong enough.</p> <p>In PE this week as part of our topic on Yoga we are working on <i>Strength</i>, through working on our co-ordination coming in and out of the dog pose.</p> <p>In PSHE this week we learning how medicines work in my body and how important it is to use them safely.</p>

	<p>In RE this week we will look at the Muslim faith and identify actions, gestures and rituals used as part of their worship and ceremonies and think about why they might be important to believers.</p> <p>In Music this week we will listen to and appraise 'Shine'. We will then complete a variety of warm-up games, continue to learn the song introduced last week and develop the tune on the glockenspiel.</p> <p>Year 1/2 I.C.T is animated story books. This lesson children will add sounds to their page and attempt to include a recording of their own voice.</p>
Week 4	<p>What can I see on a globe?</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 1 Hedgehogs will be looking at measuring length using a ruler and solving length word problems. Year 1 Squirrels will be starting a new unit which looks at introducing length and height. We will be focusing on comparing length and height as well as looking at non-standard units of measure.</p> <p>Year 2 Shrews will start a new unit about time. They will tell time to 5 minutes. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be using skip counting to find answers. They will use their multiplication facts x2 x5 and x10 to help them.</p> <p>In English this week we will continue to look at our class book, 'Here We Are'. Year 1 and Year 2 will write their own guide caring for our planet.</p> <p>In Creative Learning children will name the continents in the world and find them in an atlas.</p> <p>Challenge - Can they locate some of the world's major rivers and mountain ranges?</p> <p>In PE this week as part of our topic on Yoga we are working on <i>Pace</i>, through varying our speed from fast to slow.</p> <p>In PSHE this week we are sorting foods in to the correct food groups and know which foods my body needs every day to keep me healthy.</p> <p>In RE this week we will look at Muslim and Christian ceremonies and share ideas about what the people in the pictures are doing, how they are expressing themselves and what they might be looking at, listening to, saying or singing. As well as this we will think about how they think the people are feeling and talk about the similarities and differences in the way people worship and why this might be.</p> <p>In Music this week we will listen to and appraise 'I.G.Y'. We will then complete a variety of warm-up games, continue to learn the song introduced last week. The children will then use kazoos to improvise with the song.</p> <p>Year 1/2 I.C.T is animated story books. We will be adding backgrounds to our stories and changing the font styles and size of our text.</p>
Week 5	<p>Where do polar bears live?</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 1 Hedgehogs will be starting a new unit which looks at weight and volume. In particular we will be focusing on comparing and measuring weight. Year 1 Squirrels will be looking at measuring length using a ruler and</p>

	<p>solving length word problems. Y2 Shrews will continue their unit on time. They will find durations of time and find the start/end time. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be investigating dividing by 1 and 0.</p> <p>In English this week we will look at our new book, 'Meet the Oceans'. Y1 will sequence pictures of the places visited in the story, using capital letters for Nouns. Y2 Shrews will sequence the places visited in the book. They will use consistent tense choices. Year 2 Hedgehogs will sequence the story into its main parts and focus on using a variety of sentence types.</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will identify where the equator, north pole and south pole are on a globe and an atlas. Challenge – What is it like to live close to the equator.</p> <p>In PE this week as part of our topic on Yoga we are working on <i>Standing</i>, by developing balance in various standing poses.</p> <p>In PSHE this week we are making healthy snacks and explain why they are good for my body.</p> <p>This week in RE we will be encouraging children to share their own experiences of worshipping with others if they have any experience or wish do so.</p> <p>In Music this week we will listen to and appraise 'Feel Like Jumping'. We will then complete a variety of warm-up games, continue to learn the song introduced last week. The children will then use kazoos to improvise with the song and add the glockenspiel.</p> <p>Year 1/2 I.C.T is animated story books. In this final week children will use the copy-paste function to add more pages to their book and share their books on the class story book display board.</p>
Week 6	<p>What are the oceans of the world?</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 1 Hedgehogs will be looking at comparing and measuring capacity as well as solving weight and capacity word problems. Year 1 Squirrels will be starting a new unit which looks at weight and volume. We will be focusing on comparing and measuring weight. Year 2 Hedgehogs will be looking at 2-D and 3-D shapes.</p> <p>Y2 Shrews will start a new unit on length and height. They will learn how to measure in centimetres and metres. Then they will order and compare lengths.</p> <p>In English this week we will continue to look at our class book, 'Meet the Oceans'. Year 1 will be doing a descriptive write about a submarine journey under the sea. Y2 Shrews will write a recount about a journey underneath the ocean. Year 2 Hedgehogs will write a recount of their events under the ocean.</p> <p>In Creative Learning this week, the children will name the world's oceans and label them on a map. Challenge – Why are the Southern and Arctic ocean the coldest?</p> <p>In PE this week as part of our topic on Yoga we are working on <i>leading yoga</i>, by working with my peers to move between yoga positions.</p>

	<p>In PSHE this week we are deciding which foods to eat to give my body energy.</p> <p>This week in RE we will reflect on the different ceremonies and worships we have focused on.</p> <p>In Music this week we will listen to and appraise 'I Can See Clearly Now'. We will then complete a variety of warm-up games. They will then rehearse and complete their final performance.</p> <p>Year 1/2 I.C.T is animated story books. Children will edit and up-level their story where possible for a final hand-in.</p>
