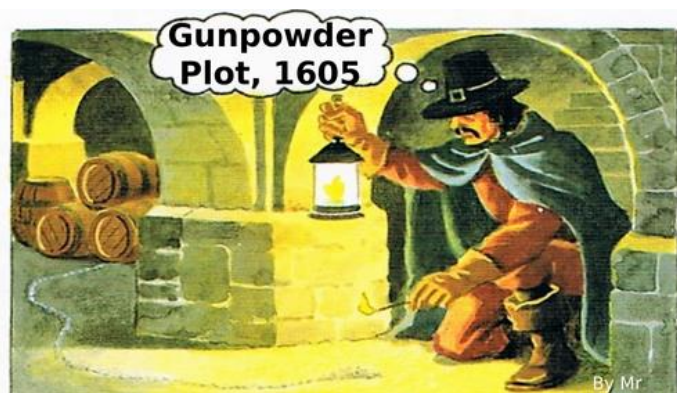

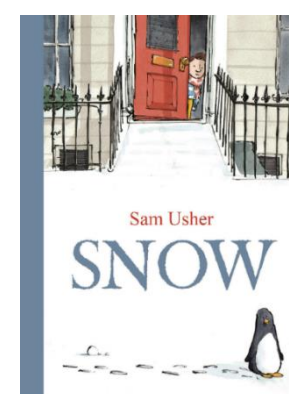
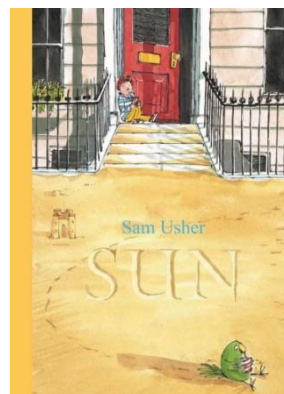
<p>Week 7</p>	<p>Who was King during the Gunpowder Plot?</p> <p>In English this week Shrews, Squirrels and Hedgehogs will look at instruction writing. They will write their own instructions to make a bonfire craft.</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 2 Hedgehogs and Shrews will continue their addition and subtraction unit. Year 1 Hedgehogs and Squirrels will focus on addition.</p> <p>In Creative learning this week the children will learn that King James I was reigning monarch. They will discover what happened during the Gunpowder Plot and why we have Bonfire Night.</p> <p>In ICT children will be creating a program using code blocks.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will begin to learn the songs for their Christmas production.</p> <p>In PSHE this week the children will start their new unit called 'Celebrating differences'. They will identify similarities between people in their class.</p> <p>In RE this week our question is 'What is so special about the Bible?'</p> <p>In PE this week the children will start their seasons dance. This week they will focus on ice dancing.</p>
<p>Week 8</p>	<p>Who is the new King?</p> <p>In English this week all classes will look at a variety of poetry and write their own firework poem.</p> <p>In Maths this week Year 2 Hedgehogs and Shrews will continue their addition and subtraction unit. Year 1 Hedgehogs and Squirrels will continue to focus on addition.</p> <p>In Creative learning this week the children will create a royal family tree. They will learn about the new King, King Charles III.</p> <p>In ICT children will use an event, object and action code blocks.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will continue to learn the songs for their Christmas production.</p> <p>In PSHE this week children will identify differences between people in their class.</p> <p>In RE this week 'How do people celebrate a special occasion?'</p> <p>In PE this week the children will continue their seasons dance. This week they will focus on April showers.</p>

Week 1	<p>What happens in spring and summer?</p> <p>This week in Math's Hedgehogs will be starting Shape. Hedgehogs will recognise, name and sort 2D and 3D shapes. Shrews and squirrels will continue their unit on addition and subtraction.</p> <p>In English we will read the book Sun by Sam Usher. Shrews will write a letter home in role as the main character, recounting their fun sun adventure.</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will investigate what happens in these seasons. They will consider what the weather is like and what suitable clothing they would wear. They will compare the two seasons.</p> <p>In PSHE this week the children will look at bullying and begin to understand how bullying might feel. As well as this, the children will look at ways to help if someone is being bullied.</p> <p>In PE this week the children will continue their seasons dance. This week they will focus on beside the seaside.</p> <p>In ICT children will continue to use code blocks and notice when their code executes when their program is run.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will continue to learn the songs for their Christmas production.</p> <p>In RE this week our question is 'who has a special birthday?'</p>
Week 2	<p>What season is it now?</p> <p>In Math's this week Hedgehogs will be consolidating their learning around place value. Shrews will begin their money unit. Squirrels will finish off addition and subtraction.</p> <p>In English we will read the book Storm by Sam Usher. Shrews will write a setting description of the storm whilst flying their kites.</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will learn about autumn and go on a walk around school looking for signs.</p> <p>In PSHE this week Year 1 and 2 will try to solve problems and learn who to talk to if they were feeling unhappy.</p> <p>In PE this week the children will continue their seasons dance. This week they will focus on beside the seaside.</p> <p>In ICT children will edit a scene by adding, deleting and moving objects. They will change the size of objects using the properties table.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will continue to learn the songs for their Christmas production.</p> <p>In RE this week our question is 'how did Jesus get his name?'</p>
Week 3	<p>What happens in winter?</p> <p>During Math's this week Hedgehogs will be consolidating their learning around addition and subtraction. Shrews will continue their money unit. Squirrels will begin their unit on shape.</p>

	<p>In English we will read the book Snow by Sam Usher. Shrews will begin to write their own snow adventure story.</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will investigate what happens during this season. They will compare all of the seasons.</p> <p>In PSHE this week the children will look at how to make new friends.</p> <p>In PE this week the children will continue their seasons dance. This week they will focus on Harvest.</p> <p>In ICT children will create a design plan for their program.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will continue to learn the songs for their Christmas production.</p> <p>In RE this week our question is 'how do Christians celebrate Christmas?'</p>
Week 4	<p>Reflection week</p> <p>This week in Math's Hedgehogs and squirrels will be consolidating their shape unit. Shrews will consolidate their learning from this term.</p> <p>In English we will continue to look at the book Snow by Sam Usher. Shrews will continue to write their snow story adventure.</p> <p>In PSHE this week Year 1 and 2 will be celebrating differences and will be discussing how we all are different and celebrating this.</p> <p>In Creative Learning the children will create their own weather reports as a reflection project.</p> <p>In PE this week the children will perform their seasons dance.</p> <p>In ICT the children will create their own program based on last week's plan.</p> <p>In Music the children will continue to learn the songs for their Christmas production.</p> <p>In RE this week our question is 'why is gift giving important at Christmas?'</p>
