




Where in the world is Kenya?

Week 1	Where is Africa on a world map?
	In English we read our new book, 'Lila and the Secret of Rain'. The children will write their own setting description.
	In Maths Shrews will be revisiting addition and subtraction. Squirrels will be learning place value within 100. Year 1 Hedgehogs will be finishing off their
	Geometry unit looking at describing position.
	In Creative Learning we will be going on safari to Kenya. The children will recall their knowledge from last half term by labelling the continents of the
	world and finding Africa. They will discuss how we could travel to Kenya.
	In ICT children will explore how a story can be presented in different ways.
	In PSHE Year 1 will understand the life cycles of animals and humans. Year 2 will recognise cycles of life in nature.
	In PE children will start their Tri Golf unit. Children will understand where to stand safely when playing Tri-Golf games
	In RE we will answer the question Who was The Lost Son? In Music the children will listen to and learn the words to the 'Sunshine song' part one.
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Week 2	What is the climate and weather like in Kenya?
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	In English we will continue with our book, 'Lila and the Secret of Rain'. The children will write a thank you letter to the rain.
	In Maths Shrews will be revisiting measures. Squirrels will continue to explore and compare place value. Year 1 Hedgehogs will be starting their place
	value within 100 unit.
	In Creative Learning this week the children will be planning what to take with them on safari. They will look for clues about what the weather is like in
	Kenya using photographs to help. They will then find out about the climate in Kenya in relation to the equator and how it changes through the seasons.
	In ICT children will make a quiz about our class topic.
	In PSHE Year 1 will identify some things ab out themselves that has changed and some things that have stayed the same. Year 2 will understand the
	natural process of growing from young to old. They will understand it is not in their control.
	In PE the children learn how to control the distance of the ball using both putter and chipper. In RE we will answer the question Who was The Good Samaritan.
	In Music the children will play to and perform the Sunshine song part one.
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Week 3	Which animals live in Kenya?

	In Maths Shrews will be revisiting statistics. Squirrels will be learning about money. Year 1 Hedgehogs will be continuing their place value unit looking at
	comparing numbers
	In Creative Learning we will be looking at what animals live in Kenya.
	In ICT children will make a fact file about Kenya.
	In PSHE Year 1 will identify how their body has changed since they were babies. Year 2 will recognise how their body has changed since they were a baby
	and identify where they are on the continuum from young to old.
	In PE the children will control the distance of the ball in the air using a chipper.
	In RE we will answer the question What was the sermon on the mount? In Music the children will listen to and learn the words to the 'Sunshine song' part two.
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Week 4	What are the landscapes of Kenya?
	In English we will continue with our new book, 'Meerkat Mail'. The children will write a diary entry.
	In Maths Shrews will be revisiting position and direction. Squirrels will be learning about time.
	In Creative Learning children will be looking at the landscapes of Kenya.
	In ICT children will continue with their fact file about Kenya.
	In PSHE Year 1 will identify parts of the body that makes boys different to girls. They will use the correct names for these parts. Year 2 will identify and
	name correctly different parts of the body. They will also appreciate that some parts of their body are private.
	In PE the children will concentrate on controlling the distance and height of the ball using a chipper.
	In RE we will answer the question How can we follow Jesus' example?
	In Music the children will play to and perform the Sunshine song part two.
Week 5	SPORTS WEEK
	In English we will look at tourist information brochures and the children will plan to write their own.
	In Maths Shrews will be revisiting shape. Squirrels will continue time. Year 1 Hedgehogs will be starting their money unit recognising coins and notes.
	In PSHE Year 1 will understand that every time they learn something new, they change a little bit. Year 2 will understand there are different types of
	touch and they will be able to say which ones they like and don't like.
	In PE children will develop their team work skills and work together to build a Tri Golf challenge course.
	In Music the children will listen to and learn the words to the Four White Horses song part one.
Week 6	What is life like in Kenya and how is it different to the UK?

	In Maths Shrews will be revisiting multiplication and division. Squirrels will learn position and direction. Year 1 Hedgehogs will be starting their time unit

	In Creative Learning we will find out about life in Kenya and compare it to life in the UK.
	In ICT children will present to the class their fact file.
	In PSHE Year 1 will be able to tell others about changes that have happened in their life. Year 2 will identify what they are looking forward to when they
	move to their next class.
	In PE children will continue to develop their team building skills and play each other's Tri Golf challenge courses.
	In RE we will answer the question What did Jesus teach people?
	In Music the children will play to and perform the Four White Horses song part two.
