




Which material is best?



Week 1	Which pig made the best house and why?
	In Maths Year 2 will be looking at numbers to 20, counting objects to 100 and recognising 10s and 1s. Year 1 are sorting
	and counting objects of different amount from a larger group.
	In English Squirrel class will be compare and write character descriptions of the three little pigs and the wolf. The Shrews
	will plan and writing a short piece of writing inspired by the poem 'I didn't ride a tiger' to begin their year. For
	punctuation, the Shrews will focus on using capital letters for proper nouns and personal pronouns. Hedgehogs will read
	the book Perfectly Norman. They will describe their own unique abilities.
	In Creative Learning Which pig made the best house and why? We will explore the properties of different materials.
	In RE What is Islam? We will be learning about the artefacts, people and places liked to Islam
Week 2	What can we find inside the Giant's castle?
	In Maths Year 2 will be using place value charts, and learning to partition numbers up to 100. Year 1 are recognising
	numbers as words and counting on from any number with 10 or 20.
	In English We will read The Three Little Pigs and the Big Bad Book by Lucy Rowland. Squirrel class will be looking at
	rhyming within story and making up some of our own. Hedgehogs will be describing the homes of the little pigs and
	write a wanted poster for the wolf. The Shrews will also read The Three Little Pigs and the Big Bad Book, creating
	character descriptions of the pigs and the wolf using similes and impressive adjectives. The shrews will also revisit the
	importance of using full stops to punctuate their sentences correctly.
	In Creative Learning What can we find inside the Giant's castle? We will identify objects and the materials they are
	made from.
	In PSHE this week children will start their new unit 'Being Me in My World'. The children will identify some hopes and
	fears for this year and recognise when they feel worried.
	In RE Who is Allah? We will find out who Allah is and why he is important to Muslims.
	In ICT the children will discuss and create a definition of technology, finding examples of technology within the
	classroom.
	In PE the children will begin their 'Once Upon a Time' dance unit. This week they will focus on the traditional tale Jack
	and the Beanstalk. They will duet to create a sequence of Jack running away from the giant.
	In Music the children will complete a baseline quiz before finding the rhythm and appraising Music is my soul.
Week 3	Which material is best for the Gingerbread man's boat?
	In Maths Year 2 will be writing numbers to 100 in words and learning to flexibly partition numbers. Year 1 will be doing 1
	more and 1 fewer.

 In English Squirrel class will be writing their own versions of The Three Little Pigs. Hedgehogs will plan and write an alternative ending to the book. The Shrews Grammar focus will be conjunctions this week and they will create speech between Ben, the protagonist, and the three pigs who are up to mischief. In Creative Learning Which material is best for the Gingerbread's man boat? We will explore the suitability of different materials including do they float and are they waterproof. In PSHE this week the children will understand the rights and responsibilities for being a member of their class and school. In RE Who is the Prophet Muhammad? We will find out who Muhammad (pbuh) is and why he is important to Muslims. In IC Tt the children will identify examples of computers and explain their many different uses. In PE this week the children will focus on the traditional tale Little Red Riding Hood. The children will explore different movements to accompany the words spin, skip, sway and stretch. In Music the children will learn the lyrics to Music is my soul and improvise. Week 4 Which spon is the best for eating porridge? In Maths Year 2 will continue to flexibly partition numbers. Year 1 will be counting back within 10. In English We will be reading Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Squirrel class will be finding out about instructions and recipes. Hedgehogs will write a character description for Goldilocks. The Shrews will continue to focus on the features of storytelling, planning and writing their own versions of The Three Little Pigs and the Big Bad Book. In Creative Learning the children will explore which material makes the best spoon; they will need to think carefully about the material's strength, safety and water repellence. In PSHE children will listen to other people and contribute their own ideas about rewards and consequences.		
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	Bears and will learn about the features of letters, focusing on their layout and language used. They will also explore the
	use of commas in a list.
	In Creative Learning the children will sort and categorise which materials would be found in each fairy tale house,
	explaining why some materials are suitable in some locations, but not others based on their physical properties.
	In PSHE this week children discuss how to help make their class a safe and fair space.
	In RE What are the five pillars of Islam? We will find out about the five main principles of the Islamic faith.
	In ICT the children will demonstrate how technology can be used together.
	In PE this week we will focus on the traditional tale The Enormous Turnip. The children will do solo improvisation pulling
	up the turnip. Then in groups develop a celebration dance.
	In Music the children will learn to sing and play Hey friend, including their improvisations.
Week 6	Can we make a crash helmet for Humpty Dumpty?
	In Maths Year 2 will find bonds to 100 in 10s, add and subtract 1s and add by making 10. Year 1 will be learning to use
	the terms less than, greater than, equal to and the related symbols.
	In English , Squirrel class will begin reading Hansel and Gretel and explore the settings. Continuing Goldilocks and the
	Three Bears, the Shrews and hedgehogs will write a letter as Goldilocks apologising to the three bears for entering their
	home, using their furniture and eating their porridge. The shrews will also explore word classes this week.
	In Creative Learning the children will design a crash helmet for Humpty Dumpty so that he doesn't have to keep being
	put together again using their knowledge about materials. They will investigate the effectiveness of different materials then share their findings.
	In PSHE this week the children will understand how following the learning charter will help them and others to learn.
	In RE How do Muslims celebrate the prophet Mohammad's birthday? We will explore Islamic celebrations.
	In ICT the children will revisit how to log on, use a mouse and create an image using paintz.app.
	In PE this week we will focus on the traditional tale Rumpelstiltskin. The children will think of movements to portray how
	cross they are that the princess found out their name.
	In Music the children will learn hello, which features lots of different languages.
Week 7	Can Hansel and Gretel change the Witch's house?
	In Maths Year 2 will add and subtract across 10. Year 1 will be ordering and comparing numbers.
	In English children will read the book, 'Hansel and Gretel' by Bethan Woollvin. Squirrel class will make up their own
	stories inspired by Hnasel and Gretel. The Hedgehogs and Shrews will explore setting descriptions this week, focusing on
	the use of expanded noun phrases, and writing a description of the witch' house.

	In Creative Learning the children will learning how some materials can change shape by squashing, bending, twisting		
	and stretching them. They will test how different materials which are part of the witch's house in Hansel and Gretel		
	change.		
	In PSHE this week the children will recognise the choices they make and understand the consequences.		
	In RE What have we learnt about Islam? We share our learning with others.		
	In ICT the children will discuss and explore how a keyboard is used, using the arrows to move the cursor.		
	In PE this week the children will focus on the traditional tale The Ugly Duckling. They will work in groups of 5 to create		
	either sad movements for the ugly duckling or jerky/jumpy movements for the other ducks.		
	In Music the children will create musical instrumentals to accompany the song.		
Week 8	Can everyday materials be used as art?		
	In Maths Year 2 children will subtract a 1 digit number from a 2 digit number. Year 1 will be using number line to solve		
	counting on and back problems.		
	In English as part of the 'free write' sessions, the Squirrels, Hedgehogs and Shrews will read 'There's No Dragon in This		
	Story' by Lou Carter and then then write creatively about dragons in whichever way they want to.		
	In Creative Learning this week we will have an art focus. The children will discover the artist Pablo Picasso. They will look		
	at his collage work. They then will investigate collage and then create their own collage of a fairy tale scene.		
	In ICT the children will summarise and celebrate what they have learnt this half term, completing a technology quiz.		
	In Music the children will perform their renditions of Hello.
