





## Who changed the world?



Week 1	Who is significant in our lives?
6 <sup>th</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup>	In Maths Year 1 pupils will be completing end of block assessments and revisiting counting and sorting objects. The
November	Shrews and Y2 Hedgehogs will learn to add and subtract across a ten.
November	In English Squirrels will be learning about capital letters and proper nouns. The Shrews and Hedgehogs will begin reading
	Dr Ranj's Superhero like you and retrieve information about "everyday heroes". They will recap the use of capital letters,
	full stops, and the overuse of and for grammar. Hedgehogs will look at examples of job descriptions and identify
	features.
	In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will discuss what makes a person significant and who is significant to them.
	In <b>PSHE</b> this week the children will start their new unit called celebrating differences. The children will look at the
	assumptions and stereotypes people have about boys and girls.
	In <b>RE</b> the children will explore how is Christmas celebrated around the world?
	In <b>ICT</b> the children will develop their use of a keyboard.
	In <b>PE</b> this week the children will learn how to play Boccia.
	In <b>Music</b> the children will learn and practice their songs for the Christmas play.
Week 2	Can I vote?
13 <sup>th</sup> to 17 <sup>th</sup>	In Maths Year 1 pupils will be consolidating their learning so that are confident in comparing groups and finding 1 more
November	or 1 less than a number. The Shrews and Y2 hedgehogs will find 10 more and less of a number and learn how to subtract
	two-digit numbers, including across a ten.
	In English Squirrels will be reading A superhero like you by Dr Ranj and will continue to develop their sentences writing
	using capital letters correctly. The shrews will continue to read Dr Ranj's Superhero like you and look at the features of a
	non-chronological report. For grammar, they will explore the use of conjunctions. Hedgehogs will look at co-ordinating
	conjunctions and use these when writing a job advert for a 'real' superhero job.
	In Creative Learning the children will learn about Emmeline Pankhurst, Emily Davidson and The Suffragettes,
	understanding why they are important to Britain.
	In <b>PSHE</b> this week the children will continue to look at the assumptions people make about boys and girls.
	In <b>RE</b> the children will begin to find out about the birth of Jesus.
	In <b>ICT</b> the children will continue to develop their use of a keyboard.
	In <b>PE</b> this week the children will challenge themselves playing Boccia Blast.
	In <b>Music</b> the children will learn and practice their songs for the Christmas play.

Week 3	Who was the lady with the lamp?
20 <sup>th</sup> to 24 <sup>th</sup>	In Maths Year 1 pupils will be consolidating their learning so that are confident in using their number bonds to 10
November	including revisiting fact families. The Shrews and Y2 hedgehogs will finish their unit on addition and subtraction by
	completing number sentences, solving missing numbers problems, and consolidating.
	In <b>English</b> Squirrels will continue their work based on A superhero like you by writing their own superhero story starring
	themselves. The shrews and hedgehogs will begin reading Paddington goes to hospital and look at the features of a
	postcard. For Grammar, the shrews will explore tenses and suffixes (ed, ing). Hedgehogs will look at how to use question
	marks correctly and continue their work on co-ordinating conjunctions. They will look at the features of a postcard.
	In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will learn how Florence Nightingale improved nursing.
	In <b>PSHE</b> this week the children will identify how someone who is bullied feels and what they can do to be kind to them.
	In <b>RE</b> the children will find out about who was involved in the Nativity.
	In <b>ICT</b> the children will learn how to change text in a Microsoft Word document by navigating the toolbar.
	In <b>PE</b> this week the children will learn how to play 'New Age Kurling'.
	In <b>Music</b> the children will learn and practice their songs for the Christmas play.
Week 4	Who took care of everybody?
27 <sup>th</sup> Nov to	In <b>Maths</b> Year 1 pupils will be consolidating their learning so that are confident using addition within 10. The Shrews and
1 <sup>st</sup> Dec	Y2 hedgehogs will learn to recognise 3D and 2D shapes by counting its sides and vertices.
	In <b>English</b> Squirrels will begin reading Paddington at the hospital and will write some non-fiction text about hospitals.
	The shrews will continue reading Paddington goes to hospital and will write an informal letter to Aunt Lucy. For
	Grammar they will continue to learn about tenses and different word groups. Hedgehogs will write a postcard to Aunt
	Lucy. They will then look at the story structure of 'Paddington goes to' stories.
	In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will learn about Mary Seacole and discover how she helped improve nursing.
	In <b>PSHE</b> this week the children will recognise what is right and wrong and know how to look after themselves.
	In <b>RE</b> the children will continue to explore and retell the Nativity story.
	In ICT the children will select text by clicking and dragging.
	In <b>PE</b> this week the children will continue to practice their aim in 'New Age Kurling'.
	In <b>Music</b> the children will learn and practice their songs for the Christmas play.
Week 5	Can I sit here?
4 <sup>th</sup> to 8 <sup>th</sup>	In <b>Maths</b> Year 1 pupils will be consolidating their learning so that are confident in subtraction within 10. The Shrews and
December	Y2 hedgehogs will find lines of symmetry on shapes and use lines of symmetry to complete shapes.

	In English Squirrels will continue their non-fiction writing about hospitals. Hedgehogs will generate their own
	Paddington story, using the usual format to help them structure it. The shrews will begin to read Izzy Gizmo and create
	their own inventions, making persuasive posters to advertise them. They will also revisit the use of commands,
	questions, statements and exclamations.
	In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will find out about the life of Rosa Parks and how she fought against discrimination.
	In <b>PSHE</b> this week the children will understand that we shouldn't judge people if they are different.
	In <b>RE</b> the children will explore how Christmas is celebrated in the UK.
	In ICT the children will change their text using the new skills they have learnt then explain their changes. They will learn
	to use the 'undo' to remove changes.
	In <b>PE</b> this week the children will challenge themselves in 'Through the Gate' Kurling.
	In <b>Music</b> the children will learn and practice their songs for the Christmas play.
Week 6	DT focus week – wheels and axels
11 <sup>th</sup> to 15 <sup>th</sup>	In Maths Year 1 pupils will children sort and group 3-D shapes more formally according to simple properties, including
December	type, size and colour. As well as sorting shapes themselves, children also identify how given groups of shapes have been
	sorted. The Shrews and Y2 hedgehogs will lean to count the faces, sides and vertices of a 3D and sort them into
	categories.
	In <b>English</b> Squirrels will read Izzy Gizmo and write about their own inventions. The hedgehogs will also read the story
	and write an informal letter to Izzy, encouraging her to continue to make inventions and to not give up. They will use the
	subordinating conjunction because. The shrews will continue to read <i>Izzy Gizmo</i> and write a set of instructions
	explaining how to use/build their inventions. They will focus on using the correct tenses and the four sentence types.
	In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will design and make their own emergency vehicle.
	In <b>PSHE</b> this week the children will understand how differences makes us feel special and unique.
	In <b>RE</b> the children will continue to explore how Christmas is celebrated in the UK.
	In <b>ICT</b> the children will compare typing and writing. They will explain the differences and which one they prefer.
	In <b>PE</b> this week the children will play a range of traditional playground games.
	In <b>Music</b> the children will learn and practice their songs for the Christmas play.
Week 7	How can I change the world? Children to come up with their own invention or ways of how they want to change the
