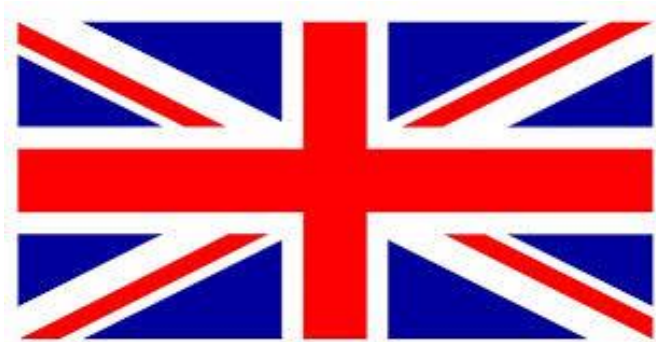

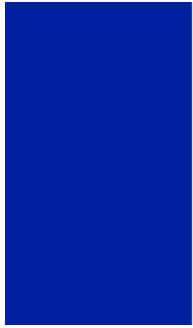

Meals

- Children require 2 packed meals for the journey – 1 for breakfast and 1 for lunch. They MUST have a refillable water bottle, which can be refilled at numerous water points at the chateau
- A supply of cereal bars or similar snacks would be a good idea, however, we are not permitted to take packs of cheese or meat into France
- All other meals during the stay are provided.

Unlimited salad bar, a combination of plain salad items, alongside a wide variety of composite vegan and meat salads are available at dinner daily.

Fresh fruit is available at all meals

There are freshly-prepared hot or cold options available at every mealtime and a self-service salad bar for children to help themselves to as much salad as they like at lunch and dinner. Homemade soup is available most days and there is plenty of bread and fresh fruit available, as well as hot and cold drinks.

We know that some children are very particular about what they eat and if the menu doesn't suit, we can provide alternatives to ensure no-one leaves the dining room hungry. We do often find, however, that children are more likely to try new things at PGL that they wouldn't normally eat at home - it's all part of the PGL experience!

Accommodation

- Pupils will be in rooms of 3 or 4.
- All rooms have their own shower and toilet.
- Staff rooms will be situated next to pupil rooms and will be easily identifiable to the children



Luggage

- Space for luggage is limited.
- Pupils are allowed one large holdall or suitcase to be kept in the luggage hold until we reach the centre.
- A smaller bag can be kept in the coach. This should contain packed lunches, a refillable water bottle and magazine or pocket game for the journey.



Clothing

- Pupils will need comfortable clothing for the journey.
- Sensible shoes or trainers will be required as there will be a lot of walking!
- A waterproof will be necessary
- A small back pack would be very useful
- A torch – localised planned power cuts to save energy

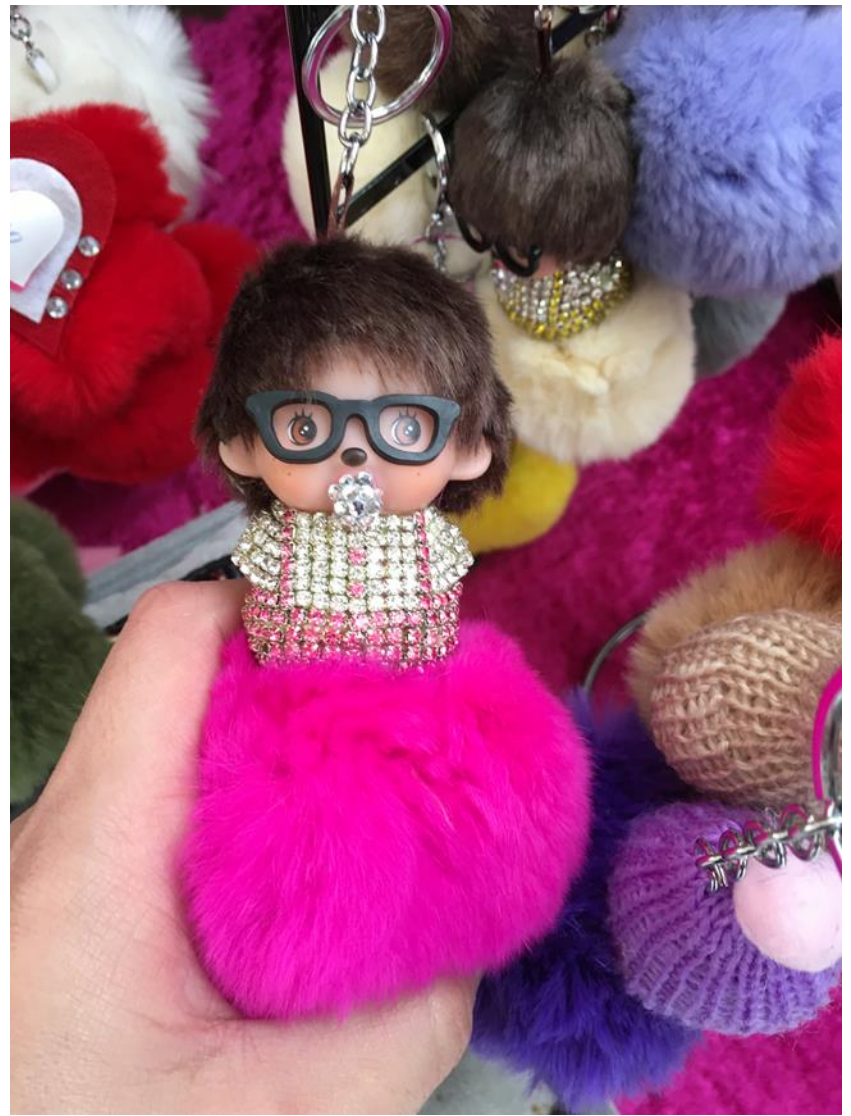
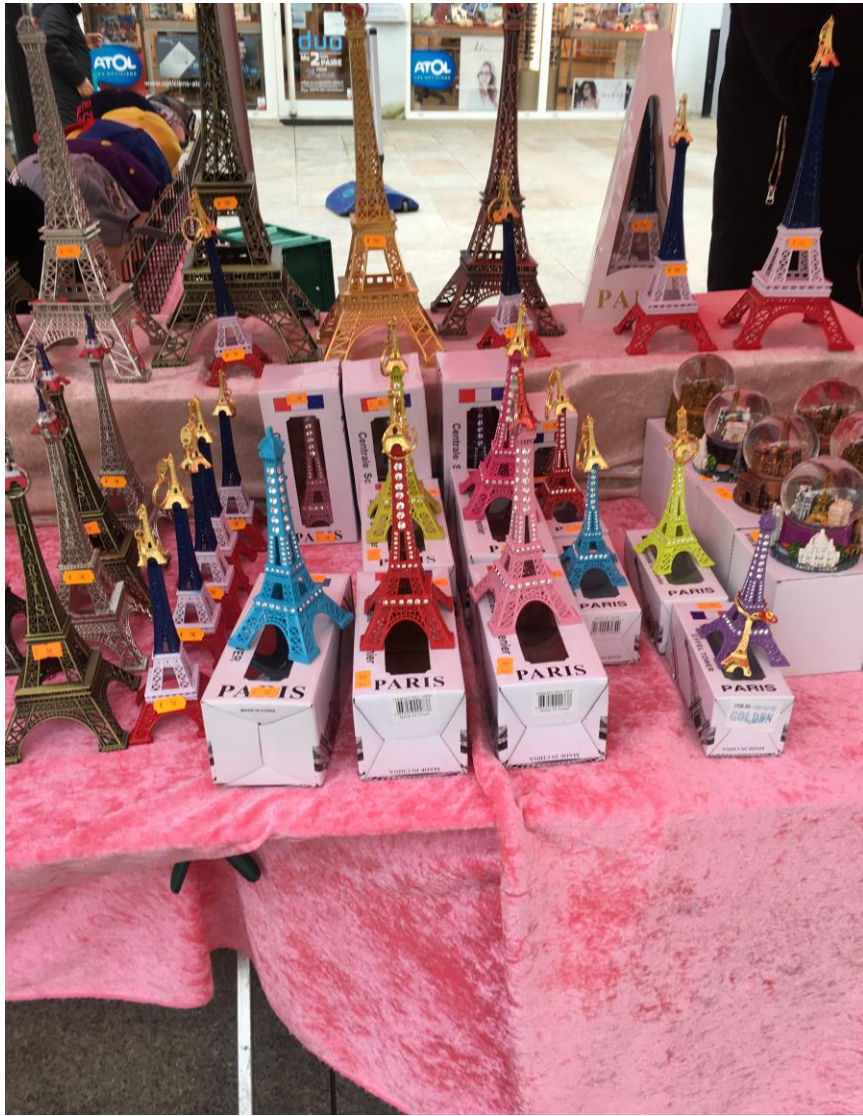
Personal Possessions

- 75 euro total.



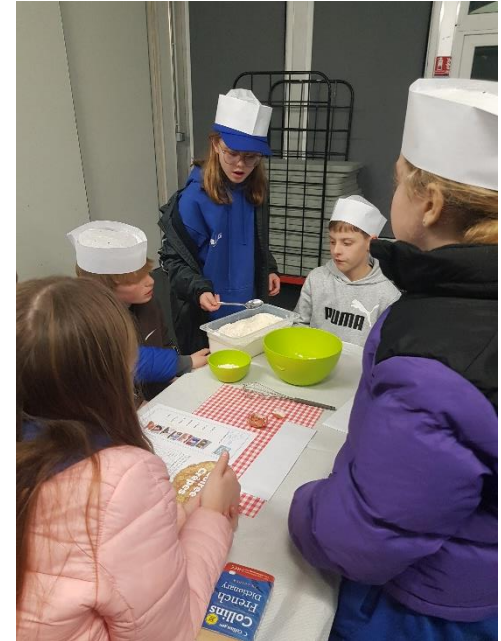


Monday

- Pupils to arrive at school at 4am
- Coach will depart at 4.30am.
- The coach will reach the Eurotunnel at approximately 9.50am, and is due to arrive in France at 12.55am.
- Greeted at Chateau de Grande Romaine at around 5.30pm.
