



Unlimited salad bar, a combination of plain salad items, alongside a wide variety of composite vegan and meat salads are available at dinner daily. Fresh fruit is available at all meals There are freshly-prepared hot or cold options available at every mealtime and a selfservice salad bar for children to help themselves to as much salad as they like at lunch and dinner. Homemade soup is available most days and there is plenty of bread and fresh fruit available, as well as hot and cold drinks.

Accommodation

- Pupils will be in rooms of 3 or 4.
- All rooms have their own shower and toilet.
- Staff rooms will be situated next to pupil rooms and will be easily identifiable to the children





- Space for luggage is limited.
- Pupils are allowed one large holdall or suitcase to be kept in the luggage hold until we reach the centre.
- A smaller bag can be kept in the coach. This should contain packed lunches, a refillable water bottle and magazine or pocket game for the journey.



<u>Clothing</u>

- Pupils will need comfortable clothing for the journey.
- Sensible shoes or trainers will be required as there will be a lot of walking!
- A waterproof will be necessary
- A small back pack would be very useful
- A torch localised planned power cuts to save energy


