Free School Meals

School Meals are FREE for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Your child may also be entitled after Y2, which provides extra funding to school. You can register your child for Free School Meals if you receive any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment & Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit but not Working Tax Credit and the household income (as used by HMRC to assess tax credits) is not more that £16,190. Please note: anyone eligible for Working Tax Credit, or if you have a partner and they receive it, regardless of Income, you will not qualify
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- In receipt of the 4 week run on of Working Tax Credit (when someone becomes unemployed or reduces their hours and is no longer entitled to Working Tax Credit but will continue to receive it for a further 4 weeks and is entitled to free meals during that time)
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net household income of no more than £7,400 as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods). Your net earned income is your household income after taxes & deductions and does not include income from Universal Credit or any other benefits
