


Week 1	*Science assessment week
	In English this week we are reading the story The Pirates are Coming! Squirrels will be role playing being the main
	character Tom, and writing speech bubbles for different characters. Hedgehogs will be writing a description of the pirate
	ship and the pirates. Shrews will be writing a message in a bottle, describing their pirate ship and feelings about being
	lost at sea.
	In Maths year 1 will be finishing off their unit on Place Value to 50, looking at numberlines and one more and one less.
	Y2 Hedgehogs will start their fractions unit. They will recognise equal and unequal parts, recognise a half and a quarter.
	The Shrews will explore telling the time using half past, o'clock, quarter past and quarter to.
	In PSHE we will start our new unit about relationships. Children will identify the different members of their family,
	understand their relationship with each of them and know why it is important.
	In RE this half term children will be learning how Muslims worship. This week, they will develop their awareness of the mosque as a special and sacred place for Muslims.
	In Music, we will be exploring improvisation. They will listen and appraise 'I wanna play in a band' and begin playing
	along on their kazoos.
	In I.C.T the children will start their new unit about grouping data. This week children will label and match objects.
	Our PE this half term is Tri-Golf. This week we will learn how to stand to use a golf club.
Week 2	How do I use a map?
	In English this week we are continuing to look at the story The Pirates are Coming! and writing our own invitations to a pirate party, just like in the story!
	In Maths year 1 will be looking at length and height, measuring using objects and in centimetres. Y2 Hedgehogs will
	recognise and find a quarter and a third. The Shrews will practice telling time past and to 5 minutes.
	In Creative Learning the children will use compass points to navigate around a map.
	In PSHE the children will understand that there are lots of physical contact within a family and that some of this is
	acceptable and some is not.
	In RE we are finding out about the features of a mosque.
	In Music they will improvise and compose an instrumental segment to 'I wanna play in a band'.
	In I.C.T children will group and count objects.
	In PE this week we will be learning how to control our golf club to change the distance the ball travels.
Week 3	What is a bird's eye view?

 In English this week we are finishing the story The Pirates are Coming! with a story retell with an alternative ending. In Maths year 1 will be measuring and comparing mass and volume. Y2 Hedgehogs will find the whole. They will also look at unit fractions and non-unit fractions. Y2 Shrews will start their fractions unit. They will recognise equal and unequal parts, recognise a half and a quarter. In Creative Learning the children will use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to study geography in our school and its surroundings. In PSHE the children identify some of the things that cause conflict with their friends. In RE children will explore how Muslims pray. In Music, they will reflect on and appraise 'music is all around' and begin playing along on their kazoos.
In I.C.T children will describe an object and its properties.
In PE this week we will be controlling the use chipper and putter in golf.
 What is the geography of our school? In English this week squirrels are looking at the story 'The Pirate Mums'. We will be writing character descriptions of Billy's pirate mums, then creating pirate Wanted posters. Hedgehogs and Shrews will be starting the story, 'The Pirates Next Door'. They will write a diary in role as Tilda, summarising the pirate's arrival. In Maths in year 1 will be beginning their unit on multiplication and division. We will be looking at counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Y2 Hedgehogs will recognise the equivalence of a half and two quarters. They will recognise and find three quarters. Y2 Shrews will recognise and find a quarter and a third. The Shrews will practice telling time past and to 5 minutes. In Creative Learning the children will use simple fieldwork and observation skills to study the geography of our school and surroundings. In PSHE children will understand that sometimes it is good to keep a secret and sometimes it is not good to keep a secret.
In RE children will explore the feelings that go with a special place. In Music they will improvise and compose an instrumental segment to 'music is all around'. In I.C.T children will group similar objects in more than one way. In PE this week we will learn how to control the height of the ball in golf.
What do the symbols on a map mean?
In English this week Squirrels are continuing the story 'The Pirates Mums', and writing a description of the terrible storm! Hedgehogs and Shrews are continuing the story of 'The Pirates Next Door'. They will write in role as residents of Dull on Sea, complaining to the council about the pirate's arrival.

	In Maths in year 1 we will be recognising and making equal groups, as well as making arrays. Y2 Hedgehogs will start
	their new unit learning about length and height. Children will measure in cm and m. They will compare lengths and
	heights. Then they will order them. Y2 Shrews will find the whole. They will also look at unit fractions and non-unit
	fractions
	In Creative Learning the children will devise a simple map and use and construct basic symbols in a key.
	In PSHE children will recognise and appreciate people who can help them in their family, their school and their
	community.
	In RE the children will understand the origins of the call to prayer.
	In Music the children will reflect on and learn the rhyme of 'Saying sorry'.
	In I.C.T children will choose how to group objects and describe the groups. They will record how many objects are in a
	group.
	In PE this week we will work as a team, putting our tri-golf skills to the test.
Week 6	What are the human features of our surroundings?
	In English this week we are finishing our stories, and using both our pirate stories to help us create a guide on how to be
	a pirate.
	In Maths in year 1 we will be finishing the unit on multiplication and division, looking at making doubles. making equal
	groups and sharing.Y2 Hedgehogs will begin their mass and capacity unit. They will compare mass, measure in g and kg.
	Y2 Shrews will recognise the equivalence of a half and two quarters. They will recognise and find three quarters
	In Creative Learning the children will design a map, referring to key human features.
	In PSHE children will express their appreciation for the people in their special relationships.
	In RE children will learn about how important words are whispered to new babies, and shouted from minarets at prayer
	times.
	In Music the children will improvise and compose an instrumental segment for 'Saying sorry'.
	In I.C.T children will decide how to group objects to answer a question. They will compare groups of objects then share
	what they have found out.
	In PE this week we will work as a team, putting our tri-golf skills to the test.
Week 7	Can I make a pirate flag?
	In English this week Squirrels are reading the story 'The Pirates Next Door' and using this story as inspiration for our
	creative independent writing. Hedgehogs and Shrews will be using 'Pirate Mums' as inspiration for their creative write.
	In Maths in year 1 we will be beginning a unit on fractions, looking at recognising and finding half in objects and
	quantities. Hedgehogs will measure in ml and I. They will compare volume and capacity. Then they will read

temperature. Y2 Shrews will start their new unit learning about length and height. Children will measure in cm and m.
They will compare lengths and heights. Then they will order them.
In Creative Learning the children will design and make their own pirate flag. They will build up a design on card and print
their flag.
In RE children will learn that Muslims pray 5 times and know why.
In Music the children will compose their own song using the kazoos.
In PE the children will take part in some tri-golf competitions and games.
