




# Where do I live?

<p><b>Week 1</b></p>	<p><b>Which continent is the UK part of?</b></p> <p>In <b>English</b> this week, squirrels and hedgehogs will begin their new book, <i>The Koala Who Could</i> by Rachel Bright. They will write a character description about Kevin the koala. The Shrews will begin their new book, <i>Leon and the Place Between</i> and will write a setting description of the circus.</p> <p>In <b>Maths</b> year 1 will be finishing their unit on fractions, looking at finding quarters. Year 2 will learn how to make tally charts, create tables, block diagrams and pictograms.</p> <p>In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will be able to name the seven continents of the world and locate them on a world map. They will be also be able to locate the UK on the map.</p> <p>In <b>PSHE</b> this half term, year 1 and year 2 will be taught separate lessons. Their new topic is all about 'Changing Me'. Y1 will learn about the life cycles of humans and animals. Y2 will learn about cycles in nature.</p> <p>In <b>RE</b> this half term we will finding out how Islam helps it followers. This week they will learn why Muslims admire the prophet Muhammad.</p> <p>In <b>Music</b>, we will start our new unit 'Our Big Concert'. This week they will start to explore and learn <i>The Sunshine Song</i>.</p> <p>In <b>I.C.T</b> this half term, the children will be programming quizzes. The children will identify the start of a sequence in ScratchJr.</p> <p>In <b>PE</b> this half term we are focussing on Athletics. This week our focus is <i>Running</i>. We will begin by looking at sprinting. How we can use our arms to help us and how to begin a race.</p>
<p><b>Week 2</b> <b>*Phonics screening check</b></p>	<p><b>What are the countries and capital cities of the UK?</b></p> <p>In <b>English</b> this week squirrels and hedgehogs will continue with the book, <i>The Koala Who Could</i>. Children will look at the structure of the story and begin to plan their own version. The Shrews will continue reading <i>Leon and the Place Between</i> and begin exploring story telling and narrative structure.</p> <p>In <b>Maths</b> year 1 will be looking at position and direction. Year 2 Hedgehogs will revisit previous learning from the year.</p> <p>In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children look at Europe and locate the UK. They will learn which countries make up the UK and locate them on a map of the UK. Then they will locate the capital city for each country.</p> <p>In <b>PSHE Y1</b> will be learning that changes are Ok and that sometimes they will happen whether they want them to or not. Y2 will be learning about the natural process of growing from young to old and understand that it is not in their control.</p> <p>In <b>RE</b> this week, the children will find out why the Prophet made a good leader and why his behaviour was important.</p> <p>In <b>Music</b>, we will continue to learn and perform <i>The Sunshine Song</i>.</p>

	<p>In <b>I.C.T</b> the children will learn that a sequence of commands has an outcome and can change the outcome.</p> <p>In <b>PE</b> this week as part of our topic on Athletics, we are continuing on running but now working on distance running. We will look at how to change our running style depending on the distance and how to turn effectively.</p>
<p><b>Week 3</b></p>	<p><b>What are the features of the countries in the UK</b></p> <p>In <b>English</b> this week squirrels and hedgehogs will write their own story about an animal overcoming a fear. The Shrews will continue reading Leon and the Place Between and will write a circus-themed story.</p> <p>In <b>Maths</b> year 1 will begin their unit on place value, counting 50-100. Year 2 Hedgehogs will revisit previous learning from the year.</p> <p>In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children explore how each country within the UK has its own features and characteristics. They will learn facts about each country.</p> <p>In <b>PSHE</b> Y1 children will understand that growing up is natural and that everybody grows at different rates. Y2 will recognise how their body has changed since they were a baby and where they are on the continuum from young to old.</p> <p>In <b>RE</b> this week, the children will explain how the Prophet was kind to animals.</p> <p>In <b>Music</b>, we will explore and start to learn the song Four White Horses.</p> <p>In <b>I.C.T</b> the children will create a program using a given design.</p> <p>In <b>PE</b> this week as part of our topic on Athletics, we will begin to look at throwing. We will start by using the javelins, how to hold them correctly and how to throw them.</p>
<p><b>Week 4</b></p>	<p><b>Which towns and cities do we live near?</b></p> <p>In <b>English</b> squirrels and hedgehogs will begin another book by the author Rachel Bright called 'The Lion Inside', making links to times when they have felt 'scared' or 'small'. The Shrews will continue reading Leo and the Place Between and will create an advertisement to encourage people to buy tickets to the show.</p> <p>In <b>Maths</b> year 1 will finish their place value unit comparing numbers and finding one more/ one less. Year 2 hedgehogs will revisit telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes.</p> <p>In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will explore the place we live in. We will explore the differences between villages, towns and cities. They will describe the area we live in.</p> <p>In <b>PSHE</b> Y1 learn about respecting their own bodies and which parts are private. Y2 will recognise the physical differences between boys and girls using the correct names for parts of the body.</p> <p>In <b>RE</b> this week the children will read the story, The Old Woman and the Rich Man and the Poor Man. They will discuss the morals of the story</p> <p>In <b>Music</b>, we will continue to learn and perform Four White Horses.</p>

	<p>In <b>I.C.T</b> the children will learn how to change a given design.</p> <p>In <b>PE</b> this week as part of our topic on Athletics, we will continue to work on our throwing but this time look at discus. Again, we will learn how to correctly hold the discus and how to throw for distance.</p>
<b>Week 5</b>	<p><b>Can we design and build a new playground?</b></p> <p>Children will design and make a free-standing structure. They will consider which materials to use, how to make it strong.</p> <p><b>Sports and well-being week</b></p> <p>This week the children will complete a variety of activities which aims to develop children's well-being. They will also partake in a range of sporting activities.</p>
<b>Week 6</b>	<p><b>Where did Samuel Johnson live?</b></p> <p>In <b>English</b> this week squirrels will finish their work on the 'The Lion Inside' by writing a character description of the lion or the mouse. The shrews and hedgehogs will explore different types of poetry and write various poems.</p> <p>In <b>Maths</b> year 1 will be learning about money, recognising coins and notes. Year 2 Hedgehogs will look at the language of position. They will describe movement and turns.</p> <p>In <b>Creative Learning</b> the children will use Google Street view to look at the Samuel Johnson museum. The children will learn why he is famous.</p> <p>In <b>PSHE</b> Y1 will understand that every time they learn something new, they change a little bit.</p> <p>Y2 will learn that there are different types of touch and they will be able to say which ones they like and don't like.</p> <p>In <b>RE</b> this week, children will learn about how Muslims give to charity.</p> <p>In <b>Music</b>, we will explore and start to learn the song Down By the Bay.</p> <p>In <b>I.C.T</b> the children will create a programme using their own design.</p> <p>In <b>PE</b> this week as part of our topic on Athletics, we will finally look at jumping. We will look at how to jump from one foot to another and how to land correctly. Additionally, we will learn how to jump over hurdles using the correct set-up.</p>
<b>Week 7</b> During this week we will be 'meeting the teachers' in our new classes!	<p><b>Why is Lichfield theatre called the Garrick?</b></p> <p>In <b>English</b> this week squirrels will complete their poetry week. The Shrews and hedgehogs will continue to explore poetry, specially looking at performance poetry. They will write and perform their own poems.</p> <p>In <b>Maths</b> year 1 will be completing a week on time, looking at telling time to the hour and half past. Year 2 hedgehogs will be revisiting previous learning.</p>

In **Creative Learning** the children will look at images of the Garrick theatre. The children will learn that it is named after David Garrick. They will learn about his life and discuss how he travelled to London. Children will compare travel from 1700 to today.

In **PSHE** Y1 children will be able to discuss changes that have happened in their lives.

Y2 will identify what they are looking forward to when they move to their next class.

In **RE** this week the children will learn how Hajj helps Muslims.

In **Music**, we will celebrate all three songs by performing them all together.

In **I.C.T** the children will decide how their project from the previous week can be improved.
