


Who wears the crown?

<p>Week 1</p> <p>INSET Day</p>	<p>What is a monarch?</p> <p>In English Squirrels, Shrews and Hedgehogs class will listen to the story 'The Kings Pants' and become familiar with the modelled text, which is a letter to the King. They will start to discuss and unpick the vocabulary used in the letter.</p> <p>In Maths Year 2 will be looking at numbers to 20, counting objects to 100 and recognising 10s and 1s. Year 1 are sorting and counting objects of different amount from a larger group.</p> <p>In Topic this week the children will learn what a monarch is. They will learn who the current monarch of the UK is and travel back in time to meet 3 past queens.</p> <p>In ICT this week children will develop their understanding of what information technology is. They will identify devices that are computers.</p> <p>In Music this week children will start their unit focusing on the Hip Hop song for children – Hey You! They will listen to and appraise the song.</p> <p>In PSHE this week the children will start their new unit called 'Being me in my world'. They will discuss how they can feel special and safe in their classroom.</p> <p>In RE we will be starting a unit on Christianity. This week there will be a focus on the artefacts that belong to the Christian religion and how these are used in a Church.</p> <p>In PE this week we will start our unit of 'playground games'.</p>
<p>Week 2</p>	<p>Who was Queen Elizabeth II?</p> <p>In English Squirrels, Shrews and Hedgehogs will be exploring features of a letter and designing King Charles a pair of pants. They will also practise the spelling, punctuation and grammar that is required for writing their own letter to King Charles.</p> <p>In Maths Year 2 will be using place value charts, and learning to partition numbers up to 100. Year 1 are recognising numbers as words and counting on from any number with 10 or 20.</p> <p>In Science this week children will identify, name, draw and label basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.</p> <p>In Topic this week the children will learn about Queen Elizabeth II, our most recent queen within living memory. They will learn about her family tree and learn how she is the longest reigning monarch.</p> <p>In ICT children will consider uses of information technology in a context they are familiar with.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will complete a range of musical activities and learn to perform the song.</p> <p>In PSHE this week the children will discuss how they belong to their class.</p> <p>In RE the children will find out more about the importance of Jesus in the Christian religion.</p> <p>In PE this week we will continue to look at classic playground games.</p>

<p>Week 3</p>	<p>Who turned the Queen pink?</p> <p>In English Squirrels, Shrews and Hedgehogs will be drafting, editing and publishing a letter to King Charles, informing him of the pair of pants that they have designed for him.</p> <p>In Maths Year 2 will be writing numbers to 100 in words and learning to flexibly partition numbers. Year 1 will be doing 1 more and 1 fewer.</p> <p>In Science this week children will carry out simple tests to compare and classify and identify each taste and categorise them into sweet, salty, sour and bitter.</p> <p>In Topic this week the children will learn about digital art and create a picture of a monarch using their learnt techniques.</p> <p>In RE we will start looking at the ways in which Jesus showed his love. The focus will be on the miracle of turning water into wine.</p> <p>In PE this week we will focus on participating in playground games that require team work, developing our skills for attacking.</p>
<p>Week 4</p>	<p>Who was Queen Victoria?</p> <p>In English Squirrels and Hedgehogs will listen to the story Paddington at the Palace and explore the modelled text, which is a set of instructions. They will learn the spelling, punctuation and grammar required to write their own set of instructions. Shrews will reading 'The Princess and the Pea' and sequence the events in the story. They will begin to look at features of fairy tales.</p> <p>In Maths Year 2 will continue to flexibly partition numbers. Year 1 will be counting back within 10.</p> <p>In Science this week children will identify a variety of animals and match to its offspring.</p> <p>In Topic this week the children will learn about Queen Victoria.</p> <p>In ICT children will explore IT in environments beyond school, including home and familiar places such as shops.</p> <p>In Music this week children will continue to learn the song and also improvise with instruments.</p> <p>In PSHE this week the children will know how to make their class a safe place for everybody to learn</p> <p>In RE we will continue looking at the ways in which Jesus showed his love through the miracle in which Jesus calmed the storm.</p>
<p>Week 5</p>	<p>What was the Victorian period like?</p> <p>In English Squirrels and Hedghogs will be writing a set of instructions to make Paddington a marmalade sandwich. Afterwards, they will make the sandwich, following their own set of instructions. Shrews will be exploring other fairy tales with a twist, extending their vocabulary and learning how to use commas in lists.</p>

	<p>In Maths Year 2 will be recalling bonds to 10, finding fact families and finding related facts. Year 1 will be Compare groups by matching.</p> <p>In Science this week children will observe lifecycles over time and research the lifecycles of different animals.</p> <p>In Topic this week the children will learn about what the Victorian period was like.</p> <p>In ICT children will explore the benefits of using IT in the wider world. They will focus on the use of IT in a shop and how devices can work together.</p> <p>In Music this week children will continue to learn the song and compose using instruments.</p> <p>In PSHE this week children will recognise how it feels to be proud of an achievement.</p> <p>In RE we will look at the ways in which Jesus helped others through his miracle of the loaves and fish.</p> <p>In PE this week we will focus on participating in playground games that require team work, developing our skills for defending.</p>
<p>Week 6</p>	<p>Who was Queen Elizabeth I?</p> <p>In English Year 1 Squirrel's will listen to the story 'The Pea and the Princess' and sequence the events in the story by creating a story map. Hedgehogs will continue with their Paddington book and begin to look at the features of narrative writing. Shrews will be learning how to use conjunctions to extend their sentences, they will use drama to help to plan their fairy tales and draft their story.</p> <p>In Maths Year 2 will find bonds to 100 in 10s, add and subtract 1s and add by making 10. Year 1 will be learning to use the terms less than, greater than, equal to and the related symbols.</p> <p>In Science this week children will describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts if different types of food and hygiene.</p> <p>In Topic this week</p> <p>In ICT children will consider how they use different forms of IT safely, in a range of different environments.</p> <p>In Music this week children will continue to learn the song and practise their composition.</p> <p>In PSHE this week children will recognise the range of feelings when they face certain consequences.</p> <p>In RE we will focus on how Jesus performed miracles to help people feel better. We will focus on the story of the thankful leper and will also consider what we have to be thankful for.</p> <p>In PE this week we will look at some new playground games.</p>
<p>Week 7</p>	<p>Can I compare the 3 Queens?</p> <p>In English Squirrels and Hedgehogs will be exploring the vocabulary and the spelling, punctuation and grammar that is required for writing their own narrative. The Shrews will be writing, editing and proof reading their fairy tales and finally they will publish their story.</p>

	<p>In Maths Year 2 will add and subtract across 10. Year 1 will be ordering and comparing numbers.</p> <p>In Science this week children will make simple predictions from what they have observed.</p> <p>In Topic this week</p> <p>In ICT children will think about choices that are made when using information technology, and the responsibility associated with those choices.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will perform their song.</p> <p>In PSHE this week children will understand their choices in following the learning charter.</p> <p>In RE this week the children will learn about how Jesus made a blind man see. They will be sequencing the events in the story.</p> <p>In PE this week we will play a variety of our favourite playground games using the skills developed throughout the unit.</p>
<p>Week 8</p>	<p>In English Year 1 squirrels will draft, edit and publish their own narrative. The children will rewrite the story 'The Pea and the Princess', changing some of the events and characters. Hedgehogs will write their own Paddington adventure where he meets King Charles II. The Shrews will look at a range of bonfire poetry and begin to look at some of the features of poetry.</p> <p>In Maths Year 2 will continue to add and subtract across 10.</p> <p>In Science this week children will observe the changes across the four seasons.</p> <p>In Topic this week all of our learning from the half term will culminate in a reflective project.</p> <p>In Music this week the children will perform their song.</p> <p>In PSHE this week children will understand their choices in following the learning charter.</p> <p>In RE this week, the children will find out about how Christians celebrate the Harvest Festival.</p> <p>In PE this week we will play a variety of our favourite playground games using the skills developed throughout the unit.</p>
