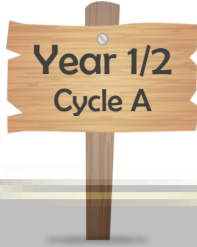


Whittington's journey through RE



Understanding the world

The children will start by learning about important people, books, special times, places, objects, and visiting places of worship. They listen to stories and talk about them, learning new vocabulary. Through hands-on experiences, they explore different beliefs and practices. Children also think about their own feelings and experiences, using their imagination and curiosity to appreciate and wonder about the world around them.



Christianity



Throughout the year the children will be taught about what Christians believe, their key symbols and stories. They will also look at how they worship and how it helps their believers.



Islam



Throughout the year the children will be taught about what Muslims believe, their key symbols and how they worship, including how they pray. They will learn about the Qur'an and how its words are used to help Muslims in life.

Children will recap what it means to be a Christian and look at someone who has been inspired by this faith.

Over the year the children will learn about the key practices of Hindus and their beliefs. They will look at the different Gods associated with this faith and how it helps them guide them with their life.

Children will recap what it means to be a Muslim and look at someone who has been inspired by this faith.



Sikhism

This year the children will look at the Sikh religion. This involves looking at their key beliefs and what it means to be a Sikh. Key festivals and traditions will be explored.



Christianity

Children will recap what it means to be a Christian and how it helps its followers deal with suffering in their lives.



Judaism

Throughout the year the children will look at the Jewish faith. We will look at where it originated and where it is followed now. The key beliefs will be studied, including their rituals for Shabbat.



Islam

Children will recap what it means to be a Muslim and at how it helps its followers through hard times in their life.

Buddhism

This year the children will look at the religion, Buddhism. We will focus on how it was first created and the key areas that Buddhists use to find enlightenment, including the Four Noble truths and Eight-fold pathway.
