



As talkers and mark makers, we will:

Storytelling: Retell key events from our stories, sequence events and act out stories together.

Vocabulary Building: We'll explore rich language around stories to describe characters using better words to describe size, emotions and feelings

Mark-Making: make pictures of family, story characters and explore autumn.



For developing our gross and fine motor skills, we will:

- negotiate space & balance by exploring obstacle courses and making models out of small and large construction materials.
- use different tools such as scissors, tweezers, and mark making tools to make things with control and accuracy.
- explore materials/tools to develop muscle strength such as playdough, threading & weaving

- learn common words I, the, no, into






As mathematicians, we will explore:

- number order by counting forwards & back by singing and exploring counting songs.
- learn how to count by 1:1 counting and subitising. (looking at a group of 1-5 objects and recognising the amounts by sight).
- how numbers can be made of smaller numbers.
- compare size of groups & know which have more , fewer or equal amounts.
- how to order objects by size and use the vocabulary of length & height



As artists, designers & musicians we will:

- learn how to mix Primary colours to make new ones.
- draw & paint portraits of themselves, family & story characters.
- learn about how artists depicted portraits in different ways & explore for themselves.
- sing nursery rhymes & familiar songs.
- use instruments to retell stories and explore volume and rhythm.
- act out stories using puppets & role play.
